

Tying the Cincture

1. Grab your cincture and double it. Then wrap it around your back.
2. Now take that loop and flip it over on itself, so it looks like the eyes of the Snake-devil peering at Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden.
3. Now take the "bitter end" with the two rattles and slip it through those two snake eyes. Cinch it up tight on your left side. Now you're set to read the Word.
